a. Tom Ashbourne Studio & Gallery

A visit to Tom Ashbourne's studio offers a rare chance to experience sculpture up close. Known for his distinctive stone and multi-media works, Ashbourne creates pieces where texture, movement, and scale reveal themselves fully in person — in a relaxed space where visitors can explore freely or connect directly with the artist.

b. J. Douglas Thompson Fine Paintings

Visit a working artist's studio where light and water take centre stage. J. Douglas Thompson's paintings capture everything from crashing waves to shifting clouds — and visitors are invited to meet the artist and explore the work in a peaceful, rural setting.

c. ANDARA Gallery

An award-winning contemporary gallery in the heart of Prince Edward County, ANDARA Gallery invites visitors to meet the artists behind the work, explore a vibrant collection of paintings, photography, digital art, and ceramics, and take part in hands-on workshops in a welcoming, light-filled space.

d. Oeno Gallery

Set on the grounds of Huff Estates Winery, Oeno Gallery is a destination for contemporary art in Prince Edward County. Explore a three-acre sculpture garden featuring over 100 large-scale works, alongside a curated gallery of Canadian and international artists — the ideal destination for collectors, designers, and art enthusiasts.

e. Guildworks

Located in the heart of Bloomfield, Guildworks is a curated gallery dedicated to contemporary Canadian craft. Featuring ceramics, textiles, glass, and more, it's a space where beautifully made objects are meant to be lived with — and where every piece tells a story.

f. County Creative

Located in Picton, County Creative blends a fine art gallery with hands-on creative experiences. Explore original work by Canadian artists, then step into the studio to try pottery painting, workshops, and events designed to bring creativity to life.

g. Melt Studio & Gallery

Set inside a historic WWII air force barracks, Melt Studio & Gallery blends contemporary art with a working encaustic studio. Featuring a curated selection of Canadian artists and rotating exhibitions, it's a space where visitors can explore, ask questions, and experience art in an approachable, welcoming environment.

h. Mad Dog Gallery

Set in a restored timber-frame barn near Sandbanks, Mad Dog Gallery offers a relaxed countryside setting to explore a diverse collection of fine art by local Prince Edward County artists. With rotating exhibitions and gardens to wander, it's a place to slow down and discover something unexpected.

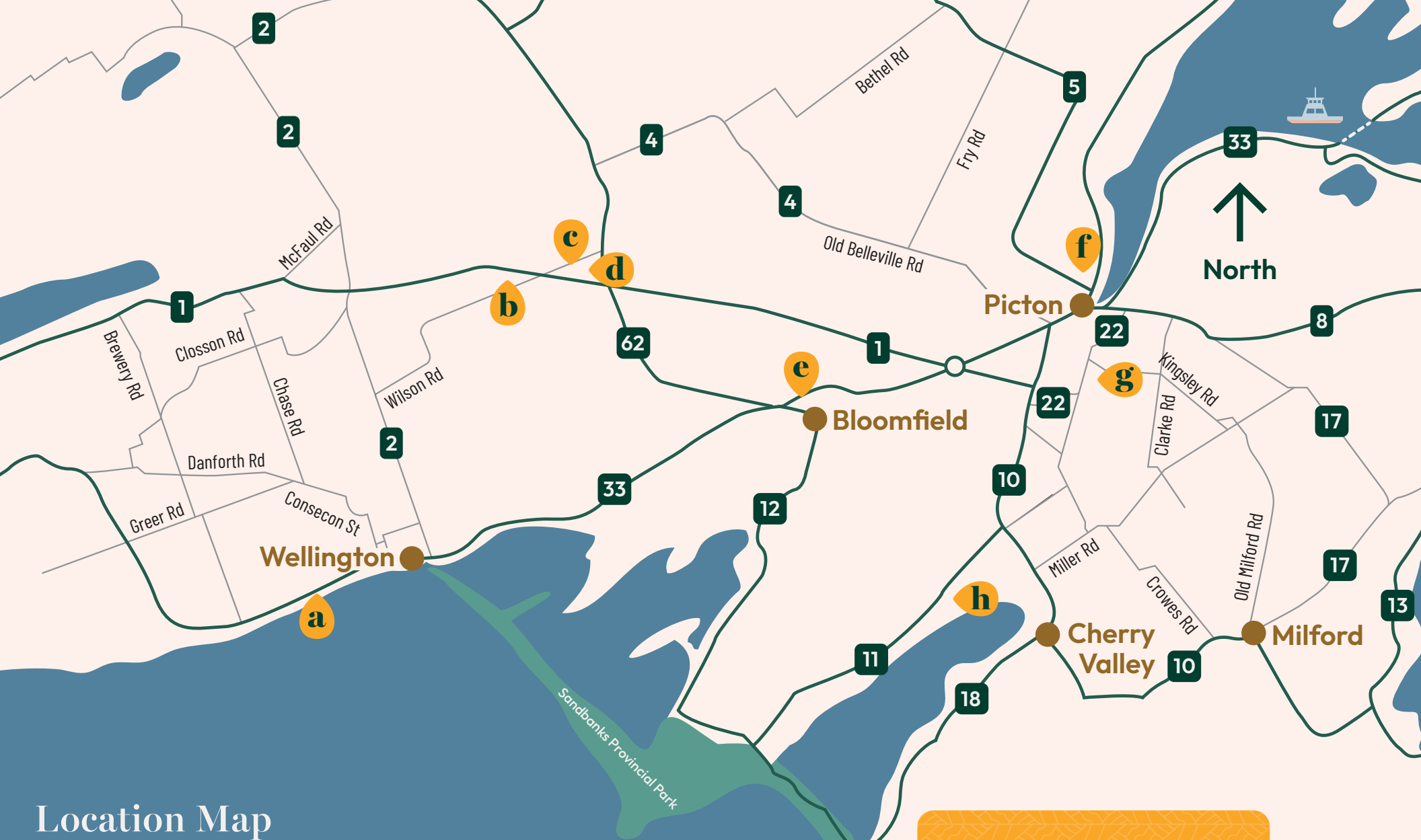
